PICKING UP AT THE END OF THE SCHOOL DAY

Our school is a very busy place and in the afternoons, our school administrator Miss Stephen will be the only person in the office and not always at her desk to answer calls, Whilst we appreciate that there may be changes to your child's after school arrangements from time to time, we would request that, as far as is practically possible, your child is aware of who is picking them up at the end of the day which will minimise the amount of messages having to be relayed to pupils very close to 3pm. On a similar note, whilst we are happy to accommodate pupils being collected from the main reception at 3pm <u>in exceptional circumstances</u>, this is not something we would encourage or be able to facilitate as an ongoing arrangement (unless a particular situation has been discussed with myself). Pupils who attend After School Care will continue to be picked up from the main reception.



COVID MITIGATIONS and MININISING RISK

As you are well aware, COVID is still very much in our midst at community level and, as a school, we continue to follow stringent procedures to minimise the risk of transmission in school.

If anyone in your household is displaying any symptoms of COVID (new or persistent cough, temperature of 37.9 degrees or above, or loss of smell or taste), then pupils (over 5 years old) from that household <u>MUST NOT</u> attend school until the symptomatic person has received a negative PCR test. Although these are the classic symptoms of COVID, the link below also outlines "extended COVID symptoms, which I would ask you also to be aware of.

If a pupil, over 5 years old, is identified as a close contact of someone who has tested positive for COVID, they must isolate and not attend school until they have received a negative PCR test.
