PICKING UP AT THE END OF THE SCHOOL DAY

Our school is a very busy place and in the afternoons, our school Administrator Miss Stephen will be the only person in the office and not always at her desk to answer calls. Whilst we appreciate that there may be changes to your child's after school arrangements from time to time, we would request that, as far as is practically possible, your child is aware of who is picking them up at the end of the day which will minimise the amount of messages having to be relayed to pupils very close to 3pm.

On a similar note, whilst we are happy to accommodate pupils being collected from the main reception at 3pm <u>in exceptional circumstances</u>, this is not something we would encourage or be able to facilitate as an ongoing arrangement (unless a particular situation has been discussed with myself).

Pupils who attend After School Care will continue to be picked up from the main reception.

All pupils in <u>P1 & 2 MUST</u> be collected at the end of the school day by a known adult. It would be preferrable if pupils in P3 are also collected by a known adult, however if you feel your child is mature enough to leave the school grounds at the end of the day by themselves then we would ask that you e-mail the school to make us aware of this. This information will then be shared with the class teacher.

Our P1 & P2 playgrounds are very busy at the end of the day and we would respectfully request that parents wait at a reasonable distance from the doors the children will be exiting from. This is to enable the class teachers to identify the known adult collecting specific children.

Picking Up throughout the School Day

In the interests of good attendance we would ask that requests to pick children up early during the school day are kept to an absolute minimum.

Our Safeguarding Policy is that we require 24 hour notice if a child has to be picked up from school early for a particular reason and the person listed as the Main Contact on our system <u>has</u> to be the person collecting. If it is someone other than the Main Contact who comes to collect a child throughout the school day, we will not release the child until we have verified this with the Main Contact on our system. This is in the interests of Child Protection.

School Car Park

Two members of staff yesterday reported to me that several pupils were walking through the staff car park at the start and end of the school day, to get to or from their playground.

At Assembly I remind pupils regularly that they should not walk through the staff car park, unless they are late arriving at school and need to come in through the main reception. They should walk through the school grounds to reach their assigned playground or their exit point.

I would also request that parents of our younger children do not walk through the car park with their child at the start or end of the day, but also walk around the school grounds instead.

Our car park is an extremely busy place at 9am and 3pm and walking through it is unsafe and may result in an accident which we wish to avoid at all costs.

PE / Outdoor Learning Days

Over the next week, class teachers will issue information about PE Days / Outdoor Learning Days as well as the learning which will take place this term, via their class newsletter.



Please take time to read the following paragraph carefully:

On PE / Outdoor Learning days, children should continue to come to school dressed with a school polo shirt and sweatshirt on top but may wear bottoms which are suitable for PE / Outdoor Learning. Pupils should <u>not wear casual tops on PE or Outdoor Learning</u> days, it is only bottoms which should be casual and suitable for PE/ Outdoor activities.

We would also request that pupils bring a change of footwear for PE days (indoor shoes). These may be brought in each PE day or may remain in school for the session.

If you require support accessing school uniform, please contact the 'Benefits' section of Aberdeenshire Council who may be able to assist you. We also do have some spare sweatshirts and polo shirts in school should you require some of these.

WATER BOTTLES

As the majority of our school based COVID mitigations have been lifted, pupils are now permitted to drink from our water fountains. To minimise disruption to learning I would still encourage parents to provide their child with a water bottle to drink from throughout the school day. Whilst we would prefer that children only have water in their water bottle, should your child not like to drink water, they may be permitted to have WEAK diluting juice in their bottle.

As you know, our main form of communication with parents, including newsletters, is via the "Xpressions" App and the school Facebook page. Newsletters are also uploaded onto the school website. To ensure you do not miss out on vital information, Aberdeenshire Council are now requesting that all parents be signed up to Parentsportal. Should you require any support with this please contact the school office.
