#### Nursery Admissions (ELC)

The admissions fortnight for EL&CC applications will be from 23rd January until 3rd February 2023

There is a key change to enrolments this year in that:

Children who have not reached 5 years old by the August 2023 school commencement date are now entitled to a funded deferred year of ELC. There is no longer a need for them to separately apply for a





deferral. (children who are 5 before the start of school in August will not be considered for deferral).

#### WET WEATHER INFORMATION

Should the weather be inclement in the morning, playground doors will be opened at 8:50am.

In this respect I would request that pupils do not arrive at school

before this time and, preferably as close to 9am as possible on wet weather days. If the weather is inclement at lunchtimes, children who are returning from home dinners should return to school no more than five minutes before the bell. On their return to school, pupils should enter via the main door as individual playground doors will not be open. It is also important that children are dressed appropriately with warm clothes and a cosy jacket for the winter weather as the playground can be a very chilly place.
